- To support the integration with the new culture

Implementation

- 1. Inclusion in pre-primary or primary school class (6–10-year-olds)
- 2. Reception class VALO (11–16-year-olds)





Structure

Yearly

- Two terms
- Longer breaks between the terms (roughly two months in June-July and 2-3 weeks in December-January)
- An autumn break in October and a winter break in February
- A few national holidays (typically 1 day at the time) along the year (Easter, Independence Day etc.)

Weekly

- School day according to the given timetable (roughly 8/9-13/14 o'clock)
- 4-6 lessons and many breaks per day ©
- Free lunch every school day
